In this article, you'll learn about how to avoid being taken in by a fake book. We'll discuss the trends and the methods in which a "huru hara" is produced and distributed, as well as some tips on how to have a good defense against it. False books have been around for centuries, but their appearance in internet communities has increased rapidly in recent years. With e-readers becoming more popular, anyone with time and equipment to spare can create an ebook that appears real from any distance or angle. The terms "huru hara" or "book scam" are often used to describe these fake books. The ability to reproduce quality images, read an e-reader, typeset, create ebooks and distribute them to millions of people around the world has made this scam possible. So how can one avoid falling for this scheme? We'll outline some of the basics of how this scheme works so you can catch on quickly. Then we'll list some tips that will help you take steps to protect yourself against it. There are existing guides online that can help you protect yourself but they tend to be either too technical or general in nature. This article aims to provide a middle-ground: enough information and direction that you can be conscious of your actions and understand the basics, but not so much that you get buried under useless information. The reason this scam is possible is because images can be easily copied and pasted. An author's book cover image, his name, title of the book, and any ISBN number given for the books can be replaced with a different image. The same goes for any review or "testimonials" given. For example: we can take an image of a certain writer's book cover and remove the title and name, then replace it with another title and person's name. The replacement title can be one that is very attractive to readers. With the same image, we can paste some fake text in it and create a new book. Then we can upload it to different websites for sellers to sell or download for free. If you view the original website, it will show where the image came from so you can check if it's real or not. But who reads webpages anymore? People only read ebooks now – they don't have time for webpages anymore! So let's say someone downloads a book from a certain website and typesetting differs from the original cover image. They also see a very attractive title in the book which they'd like to read. How does the scam work here? Substituting a name in a book for another person's name can be done through a simple image editing program. Someone made up a fake author and replaced the author's birth date with that of an author that is alive today. This particular technique rather popular since it is easy to do and only requires the use of Photoshop or similar image editing programs. The texts inside can also be altered to make them look more appealing.
